Registration week 20 - 24 May 2019

What you need to do for registration:

1. Finance & Fees



Self-funded students, please pay your semesters tuition fees in full.

Student Finance England does not fund summer studies.

**Note: If you have failed any of your exams / required modules you may be able to apply to CRIC to study in the summer. You will need to attend a registration appointment to discuss this with the CRIC Academic and Finance team*

2. Book your registration appointment



- You will be sent an email with the booking link. Please only select one appointment slot. Bring the following to your appointment:
- Passport / Birth Certificate or National ID
- Proof of UK term time address - Accommodation contract / Bank statement / Utility bill

3. You must update your eVision



Login into <https://e-vision.anglia.ac.uk>

Username: Your ARU Computer login. (e.g. CR75); Password: Your ARU Computer password.

You should update your contact details and if applicable re-register on eVision.



Timetable released during registration week.

You will receive an email when your timetable is released on your student portal Axis. Usually 48 hours after you have completed your registration appointment.

If you have failed a 15 credit module. You may apply to study in the summer semester. You will need to complete a CRIC Learners Support Fund Application with the CRIC office for consideration.

If you have failed more than 15 credits you will need to repeat those modules you must contact the CRIC academic team to discuss your options.
